7. The Interveners who have requested a copy of Exhibit Book, Volume 1 will enter into a personal undertaking to abide by the confidentiality agreement of the parties.
8. The Interveners have no right to appeal any decision in the proceeding, unless it bears directly upon their participation as an intervener in the matter.
9. The Interveners will not seek, nor be made subject to, any order as to costs, unless they fail to respect any conditions for their intervention set by the Court.
10. There will be no costs of these motions.
